Social Development

Accept school routine
Display self-control
Work and play well with others
Share and take turns
Adjust to new situations
Respect property and rights of others
Help put things away at clean-up time
Develop self-confidence

Gross Motor Development

1. Identify and use body parts
2. Walk a balance beam
3. Run
4. Jump
5. Hop
6. Throw, catch ball with limited control

Listening Skills

Listen attentively to stories without interrupting
Identify sequence of events in stories
Repeat simple rhymes and distinguish rhyming words
Repeat a pattern of series of words, sounds or numbers
Follow 3 verbal directions in sequence

Language Development

Speak in complete sentences of 4 to 5 words
Name common objects and pictures
Name basic colors, shapes and sizes
Recognizes letters and some words
Tel stories in sequence

Visual Development

Name, match and sequence letters
Put simple puzzles together
Put numerals in order
Repeat patterning of 3 or 4 items
Match colors, shapes and sizes
Identify likenesses and differences of pictures and objects
Name missing items from memory

Personal Development

Know full name
Know age
Know birthday
Know phone number
know address

Fine Motor Development

Hold crayons and pencils appropriately
Manipulate small objects with both hands

Use art implements appropriately
Hold scissors appropriately and cut
Draw basic shapes
Draw a man with six body parts
Tie knots and lace shoes
Write letters
Kindergarten
Write numerals 1-10
Finish incomplete designs
