Some of you have been wondering what our response will be to our refugee neighbors as the COVID19 disruptions continue and support services like BBM have been temporarily canceled.

I have been in communication with Refugee Hope Partners (RHP) am excited to announce our opportunity to partner with them in a sustainable and relational plan to continue to support this vulnerable community.

I am asking you to consider sponsoring a family at Cedar Point.

Sponsorship would mean you:

1. PRAY for your family regularly
2. Deliver a supplemental food box each week as long as possible using social distancing guidelines (dropping at the door - not entering apartments)
3. Include a few fun items for the kids in the box
4. Email Refugee Hope Partner staff weekly with a quick update
